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KEY FACTS

A member of 'Leading Hotels of the World', this 5* superior hotel is conveniently situated on the well-known Quai du Mont Blanc, opposite lake Geneva's renowned Jet D'Eau. Situated in the heart of the city's business and shopping district, Beau-Rivage commands incredible views of Lake Geneva and the Alps.

In 2018, the Beau-Rivage unveiled a meticulous renovation, including the restoration of its grand façade, with frescoes and marble columns, and modernised rooms and suites. The suites are named after notable guests and all have private balconies overlooking the lake, Old Town or Geneva harbour.

The Beau-Rivage is a gourmet destination showcasing talented chef Dominique Gauthier's one-Michelin starred restaurant, Le Chat Botté. This renowned restaurant was

revamped in 2015 featuring a redesigned terrace. It serves inventive contemporary French cuisine and features a private 8-person chef's table. The hotel also offers the best fine-dining Thai cuisine in Geneva at Le Patara.

Specialist spa treatments are offered by Bellefontaine skincare; their products are based on natural ingredients from the Alps, pure glacier water and the most recent discoveries in biotechnology.

Founded in 1865 by Jean-Jacques Mayer, Beau-Rivage Geneva has been under family ownership for 5 generations. It has hosted many high profile and historical figures over the years including Empress Sissi, Eleanor Roosevelt, Tomas Masaryk, Richard Wagner, Jean Cocteau, Romy Schneider and the Duke of Brunswick.

LOCATION AND ACCESS

Cornavin train station is located 5 minutes walk from the Beau-Rivage. Transfers by chauffeur-driven limousine can be arranged (price on request). Alternatively bus no. 1. direction Jardin Botanique - Monthoux stops near the hotel.

Geneva International Airport is located 20 minutes from the Beau-Rivage. Transfer by chauffeur-driven limousine can be arranged (price on request). Train from Geneva airport to Gare Genève-Cornavin or bus no.10 destination Genève-Cornavin, then bus no.1 direction Jardin Botanique - Monthoux stop

The elegant charm of this exceptional suite is a tribute to the Swiss social activist, founder of the Red Cross and the first recipient of the Nobel Peace Prize.

Umberto II Suite: 105 sq.m, king or twin size bed,

spacious dressing room, spacious bathroom with bathtub, shower and Hammam, separate living room, dining room, kitchenette with espresso machine, large terrace with seating area and views to the lake and Jet d'Eau. This majestic suites honours the last King of Italy, a loyal guest of the hotel.

Sissi Terrace Suite: 125 sq.m, king or twin size bed, spacious bathroom with bathtub, shower and Hammam, separate large living room, expansive terrace with seating area and views to the lake. Decorated with precious souvenirs and period furniture, this suite takes inspiration from the Austrian Empress who chose the hotel as her pied-à-terre in Geneva.

6 Celestial Suites: *Elizabeth Taylor* (100 sq.m), *Antoine de Saint Exupery* (150 sq.m), *Jean Cocteau* (150 sq.m) - duplex suites situated on the top floor of the hotel, bedroom with king or twin size bed and a window that opens up to the sky, spacious bathroom with Hammam, bathtub and shower, separate large living room, dining area, lake view.

Imperial Suite: 150 sq.m, king size bed, spacious bathroom with Hammam, bathtub and shower, separate large living room, dining area, lake and Jet d'Eau view, connects with up to 3 bedrooms. This distinguished and harmonious Japanese inspired suite is dedicated to Japanese emperor Akihito.

Royal Suite: 250 sq.m, king size bed, spacious bathroom with shower, bathtub, Jacuzzi and steam room, large separate living room, lake and Jet d'Eau view, can be connected to a Luxury Executive and a Heavenly Suite.

All rooms and suites have bathroom amenities by Alpeor, air conditioning and a Nespresso machine.

La Terrasse: a stylish pop-up restaurant open everyday from 19th June to 6th September, serving refreshing Mediterranean-style cuisine by Michelin-star Chef Dominique

Gauthier on the hotel's legendary terrace with breathtaking views of the lake and the Alps.

Le Patara: a leading fine-dining Thai restaurant in an exceptional setting with welcoming décor, serving authentic, innovative cuisine using premium ingredients. Expert Thai Chef Jumngong Norradee, who was classically trained at the parent restaurant in Bangkok, has been at the helm since 2014.

Wine Cellar: the hotel's legendary wine cellar is filled with an impressive 20,000 bottles including the rarest and most prestigious vintages. Guests can embark on an exclusive gourmet evening of divine food and wine pairings with a menu created by Michelin-star chef Dominique Gauthier and passionate Restaurant Director and Head Sommelier Vincent Debergé.

Le Bar: a stylish bar with an open-air summer terrace, perfect for a quick snack, leisurely lunch or light dinner of

fine cuisine and cocktails and aperitifs. Every September to November weekend from 2-6pm, exquisite desserts are created for teatime by Head Pastry Chef Yohan Coiffard.

PRIVATE ROOMS

Beau-Rivage Geneva has 6 prestigious charming reception rooms bathed in natural daylight offering breathtaking views of the lake. Events can be held for over 200 people at the hotel.

Salon de Windsor: 45 sq.m, a light elegant room ideally situated on the ground floor and opening onto the hotel's atrium ; it can interconnect with the Salon Trémois. It was inaugurated during the auction of the Duchess of Windsor's jewels.

Salon Trémois: 60 sq.m, situated adjacent to the Windsor Lounge, which it interconnects with if required. Offers a superb view over the harbour and Brunswick gardens. The room is an ode to the great 20th century illustrator, sculptor and friend of the Mayer family, Pierre-Yves Trémois and inspiring works adorn the room.

Salon de Brunswick: 120 sq.m, when connected with Sarah Bernhard Salon the total floor area is 330 sq.m. The unique salon has an unrivalled atmosphere and is named after Charles II of Brunswick, one of the hotel's loyal guests and an original character, who bequeathed his fortune to the city of Geneva.

Salon Sarah Bernhardt: 80 sq.m, connects with the L'Impératrice and de Brunswick salons along with access to the terrace. An elegant sumptuous lounge named after

the famous independent 19th century French stage actress and a tribute to the women who have managed the hotel over the generations.

Salon de L'Impératrice: 130 sq.m, connects with Salon Sarah Bernhardt and Salon de Brunswick (total floor area 330 sq.m). A splendid reception room with large bay windows looking over the harbour and a magnificent terrace that offers a spectacular view of the lake, the Jet d'eau and Mont Blanc. This vast elegant lounge pays homage to Empress Sissi.

Salon Masaryk: 21 sq.m, a discreet cosy room with original stained glass windows and lemon tree woodwork; ideal for private events and business meetings. This intimate lounge was where Tomáš Mazaryk, the founder and first president of Czechoslovakia, signed the first Czech treaty of independence in 1918.

DID YOU KNOW?

Opened in 1865 by Albertine and Jean-Jacques Mayer, Beau-Rivage is the last property in Geneva to remain in a single family for five generations.

The interiors of Beau-Rivage have been authentically

crafted by skilled master glass-makers, drapers, gilders, cabinet-makers, marquetry specialists and more. Many objects have been personally selected by the owner Jacques Mayer and for over a century and a half the owning family have collected exceptional rare pieces of furniture that have been professionally restored.

Impressive historical stained glass windows, signed by Enneveux & Bonnet at the beginning of the 20th century, that were kept in the attics have been restored and now feature in the hotel's elegant corridors.

The Celestial Floors feature 17 individually styled suites dedicated to the memory of 17 illustrious personalities who have stayed at the Beau-Rivage. These include Henry Dunant, Clark Gable, Vaclav Havel, Simone Veil, Eleanor Roosevelt, Antoine de Saint-Exupéry, Japanese emperor Akihito, Charles de Gaulle, Romy Schneider, Jean Cocteau,

Princess Grace of Monaco, Marlene Dietrich, Hergé, Jacques Brel and Roger Moore. They offer the ultimate in privacy, luxury and comfort, with splendid views, huge bathrooms and authentic furnishings.

In 1967, Le Chat-Botté opened to the public. Several leading names in fine dining have held the reins since including Michelin-star chefs Lucien Leheu and Louis Outhier, followed by Richard Cressac and then in 2001 Dominique Gauthier - who has been a member of the kitchen team since 1996.

In 1873, the innovative Beau-Rivage installed one of only three lifts that existed in the world at the time and the first in Switzerland. Today, the hotel features the very latest in technology whilst retaining the personalised experience and well-being of each guest.
