KEY FACTS

Perched along the shore of Lake Geneva within a private estate of 19 hectares of parkland, Evian Resort is at the heart of celebrated spa town Evian-les-Bains.

Comprising two hotels, the Palace-rated Hotel Royal with its Michelin-starred restaurant Les Fresques, and the stylish and homely Hotel Ermitage, Evian Resort offers an exceptional spa with Evian thermal baths, a children's club, world-class concert hall, a championship 18 golf course and training centre, and a historic casino.

Designed by the architect Jean-Albert Hébrard and completely renovated in 2015, Hotel Royal became associated with an elegant and refined contemporary decor and obtained its 'Palace' label soon after in 2016. The 5 star hotel dominates the heights of Evian-les-Bains

and offers breathtaking views of Lake Geneva and the French and Swiss Alps.

One Michelin-starred fine dining restaurant Les Fresques, offers inventive and refined cuisine using exceptional produce, an award-winning wine list, a dining room with magnificent frescoes of Gustave Jaulmes adorning the ceiling, a panoramic terrace and breathtaking views of Lake Geneva.

Evian Resort was awarded a winner of the Inclusive Wellness category, at the Family Traveller magazine's Family Traveller Excellence Awards 2019. Both the Hotel Royal and Hotel Ermitage have been awarded the title of 'Star Winner' by TripAdvisor, for 5 consecutive years of being awarded the 'Certificate of Excellence'.

FACILITIES

Three fine dining restaurants: La Table at Hotel Ermitage, overseen by Chef Yann Lohez, has a sunny terrace and serves authentic and fragrant recipes with seasonal French flavors in an elegant atmosphere; Le Baccara, located within the Evian Casino, offers refined cuisine using high quality produce created by Chef Franck Miglierini; and gourmet restaurant Les Fresques at Hotel Royal, was awarded a Michelin star in 2019 for its superb gastronomic and creative cuisine developed by Chef Patrice Vander and Pastry Chef Stéphane Arrête.

Evian Resort Golf Club: Set within 148 acres of woodland parkland offering incomparable views of Lake Geneva and The Alps, the golf club comprises an award-winning 18-hole championship course, The Manoir du Golf with its seven rooms, Le Chalet du Golf and a dedicated Golf Club Academy with a 12 module programme designed to suit all levels.

Evian Source Spa: the 1,200 sq.m spa at Hotel Royal offers a unique and exclusive range of treatments with La Prairie and Comfort Zone products for wellness and revitalisation of the body, as well as a hair salon, two heated indoor and outdoor pools, Jacuzzi and fitness room. It focuses on beauty and balance through four main treatment areas: re-energy, relaxation and facial and body revelation.

Spa Quatre Terres: at Hotel Ermitage has partnered with La Phyto and Carita to offer a wide range of tailor-made beauty and relaxation treatments: hot stone massages, Chinese traditions, scrubs and wraps, slimming treatments and beauty treatments. Packages and programmes can be combined with special spa menus and personal coaches. It also offers spa experiences to children from 6 to 11 years old using Toofruit's certified ecological and organic cosmetics brand.

Les Thermes Evian is the spa centre of Evian dedicated

to well-being, health and beauty. Since the end of the 18th century, people have been visiting Evian to enjoy the benefits of its natural mineral water. From rheumatology to digestive complaints, Les Thermes Evian offers a balanced programme focusing on fitness, revitalisation and relaxation. Its spa menu incorporates water-based treatments, thalassotherapy and multi-sensory experiences using products by Skinceuticals and Thalgo.

Children's facilities: the dedicated space for babies (age 4 to 36 months) has a play area, changing room and nap room. Meals are adapted to their age and prepared by Hotel Royal's restaurant. The children's club for 3 to 9 year olds offers a 1000 sq.m space set in a landscaped park with several play areas adapted to each age, rest rooms, a stage, dressing-up area, outdoor playground, multi-sports field and a heated indoor pool. Children are supervised by a team of experienced childcare professionals. Up to the age of 15, teenagers can enjoy a wide range of à la carte activities including sports, creative arts, tournaments, music, themed parties and karaoke for example. During the French school holidays, courses are offered such as sailing, tennis, archery and skiing and activities include workshop graffiti, hip hop dance, adventure trails in the park and excursions for water sports, laser games and karting.

4 tennis courts (including a covered one)

Evian One is the resort's own revolutionary catamaran, a unique vessel that has been designed to travel twice as fast as a traditional boat, while consuming half as much. It enables guests to travel comfortably and in style, whilst enjoying the views from Lake Geneva. Transfers from Geneva take 45 minutes.

Historic casino offering a traditional recently renovated games room, with 250 of the latest slot machines spread over 2 floors.

The Sport & Culture team can arrange sports and team building activities including snowshoe walks, skiing, snowmobiling, sledging and snake gliss, quad biking and cycling, hiking, rafting, sailing, rowing, water-skiing, stand up paddle, sea kayaking, zipline tree climbing, paragliding, boat trips and more.

PRIVATE ROOMS

Set in a private woodland overlooking Lake Geneva, with 230 rooms spread across two hotels located a 5 minute walk from each other, 22 modular conference rooms, a concert hall with 1200 seats, 11 restaurants and bars, a golf course, a casino and the fast shuttle Evian One - Evian resort is the ideal venue for seminars, incentives, conventions, product launches and corporate events.

DID YOU KNOW?

In 1905, the Evian Mineral Water Company commissioned the construction of a luxury hotel. A name was needed that would reflect the prestige of its future guests including King Edward VII of England who had promised to be one of the first to stay at the new hotel. The name Hotel Royal was chosen, and a special suite put aside for him.

With its illustrious history, Evian Resort is synonymous with the French Belle Epoque of yesteryear. Over the years, it has been frequented by the international elite spanning royalty, celebrities and notables over the course of two centuries - including the likes of Greta Garbo, the Aga Khan and Marcel Proust - who sought the most luxurious of accommodations as they visited the town's thermal baths. Hotel Ermitage has welcomed many counts and countesses and notable families of the era including The Schlumbergers.

The Hotel Ermitage was built to depict an Anglo-Savoyard style chalet across three floors and was totally renovated by Parisian designer Patrick Ribes in 2010.

Evian Resort is just 45 minutes from the Portes du Soleil, the largest ski area in Europe.

The history and recognition of Evian mineral water began in 1789 when the Count of Laizer, a man of science, discovered its benefits. In 1824 during the Belle Epoque, the first thermal baths opened, attracting the European bourgeoisie who came to 'take the waters'. Today Les Thermes Evian comprises aqua, wellness and fitness areas, as well a dedicated mother and baby programme.

The cellar of the Les Fresques restaurant was awarded an excellent second place in the Palace category of the

Enologie contest, the Tour des Cartes, organised by the magazine Terre de Vins. Sommelier Loïc Chavasse-Frette offers exceptional wines for sumptuous food-wine pairing.

The Grange au Lac is an exceptional 1,200 spectator concert hall located in the grounds of the Hotel Royal and Hotel Ermitage. It hosts performances from world-renowned musicians throughout the year and at their annual Evian Musical Encounters and Jazz at the Grange

festivals. It is also home to six Murano and Bohemian crystal chandeliers.

With elements of a former castle at its epicentre, the architecture of Evian Casino takes inspiration from the Byzantine dome of the Saint Sophie basilica in Constantinople. It now houses 287 slot machines, 10 gaming tables and five restaurants and bars.
